The fragmentary remains of one of the largest medieval hospitals in northern England.

Multangular Tower

One corner of York's Roman fortress and later a part of the city's medieval defences.

Yorkshire Museum

Opened in 1830, the Yorkshire Museum showcases exceptional Prehistoric, Roman and Medieval archaeology and explores the natural world through its outstanding displays and exhibitions.

Hospitium

Medieval guest house for Saint Mary's Abbey.

The huge, highly-decorated and now ruined church was where the monks prayed and worshipped God.
